management.

Q4: Discuss evidence based strategies for management of perinatal transmission of HIV.

Q5: A 3 kg, term newborn is ventilated for meconium aspiration syndrome and perinatal

asphyxia. On day 2 he has repeated desaturation episodes with increasing ventilator settings.

Discuss the approach and management.

Q6: Discuss briefly: (Any 4)

1. Management of developmental dysplasia of hip.

2. Management of obstructive uropathy in newborn.

3. Preventive strategies for metabolic bone disease.

4. Pre operative stabilisation of neonate with congenital diagphragmatic hernia.

5. Adverse antenatal doppler and possible neonatal outcome.

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
